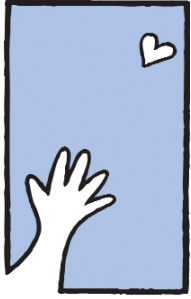

Pathways for Strong Families Begins SEPTEMBER 12, 2006

Children Ages 7-15 with Sexual Behavior Problems

This prevention program targets children who have acted out sexual behavior problems but have not been involved with the Juvenile Justice system. To help reduce the likelihood of further problems, Pathways provides group therapy for both the parent(s) and child who has identified school, behavior, family and/or substance abuse problems.

- Meets once a week, Tuesdays, 5:30 to 6:30 p.m.
- 12-week program
- Bilingual (English/Spanish)
- For children 7 to 15 years old, both those in treatment and those who have not received treatment
- Based on the work of Dr. Barbara Bonner, Center for Child Abuse and Neglect at University of Oklahoma Health Science Center
